COMMON ISSUES These result in delays • Submitted wrong business name.

- Official registration details are outdated/expired.
- Sole Proprietors from the United Kingdom can't qualify. Fails to complete any alternative methods.
- Refusal to pay more for legal/accountant signature on letter.

Comodo must verify the street address, city, state & country. PO Boxes are not accepted!

Some gov't databases or registration docs (i.e. Delaware) do not list business's address.
